



Goldendoodle Purchase Agreement and Health Guarantee

Responsibility: Payment in full must be made prior to you taking ownership of the puppy/dog. Once you have taken ownership, the breeder is free from any/all responsibilities (except those that fall under the health & genetic guarantee) for the puppy/dog. This includes all financial responsibility, and any type of care for the dog/puppy.

Initial Health Exam: BUYER has 3 days from the time the puppy leaves the custody of the BREEDER to have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian of his/her choice at BUYER'S expense to verify the general health of the puppy. If this puppy is found to have a life-threatening illness, the BUYER may return this puppy to the BREEDER at the BUYER'S expense and the puppy will either be replaced with a comparable puppy of the same value (or of greater value where the buyer is willing to pay the difference) from the first available litter of Buyer's choice. This does not include minor illness requiring short-term medication. Only LIFE-THREATENING illnesses will merit a replacement puppy. Proof of examination and diagnosis must be provided to the BREEDER within the three day period in order to receive any reimbursement of funds. The BREEDER reserves the right to a second veterinary opinion.

The BREEDER should be contacted immediately with the name and number of the licensed vet responsible for performing the exam. The licensed vet will also need to provide IN WRITING all of the results and a diagnosis. The BREEDER is not liable for any accident or injury of the animal once it leaves the Breeders premises. This warranty does not cover viral illnesses, parasites, infections, improper bites, hernias, Giardia and Coccidiosis. It also does not cover illness due to the ingestion of foreign objects, food, chemicals, stress related issues or physical injury.

The BREEDER states that this puppy has received at least one shot of the following vaccinations – Distemper, Adenovirus Type 2, Parainfluenza and Parvovirus. We deworm our puppies at 2, 4, 6, & 8 weeks. The BREEDER will provide the BUYER with the puppies' vaccine and worming records at the time of pick up.

Hips and Elbows: The Breeder guarantees hips, eyes & elbows against any genetic defects until 18 months of age. You must have official written documentation including films and any and all veterinary reports associated with the hip dysplasia diagnosis from the OFA (Orthopedic Foundation for Animals) or PennHIP of bilateral dysplasia before a replacement puppy is given. We will not honor a written statement or exams from your licensed vet, it must be documented by OFA or PennHIP and the results must be sent to our vet. If your puppy is diagnosed by PennHIP or OFA to have bilateral dysplasia, we do NOT require the puppy be returned to us. If dysplasia is confirmed, the buyer will receive a replacement puppy from the first available litter if the owner has complied with the guidelines for protecting the developing hips of the dog.

Terms of Hip and Elbow Guarantee:

- The puppy must not be allowed to become obese. (Mini Goldendoodles should not exceed 42 pounds).
- The puppy must not have suffered any trauma prior to the exam. (Broken leg/hip, etc.)
- The puppy must be given exercise, yet, not excessively. Buyer agrees not to start agility, heavy or competitive field training or any activity which may damage the puppy's bone or muscle structure until he/she has reached a minimum of 18 months of age. (Puppy needs to reach a physical maturity level which will allow such activities not to damage the animal.)
- The Buyer must be provided a copy of the licensed veterinarians and OFA findings within 10 days of finding severe hip dysplasia.
- The puppy may not have sired/whelped a litter prior to the testing of their hips.
 - ❖ The health guarantee and the hip and elbow guarantee does not cover mistreatment of puppy, injury, accidents, poisoning, etc. The dog must not be overweight, underweight and has not been used in agility, running, jumping or over exercised during their growth period of 18 months during the period of guarantee. It does not cover trauma related or environmental factors that have affected the dog adversely. We do not guarantee your dog's hips against any form of dysplasia which is attributable to non-genetic causes.

Allergies: If a member of the immediate family is allergic to the purchased puppy, and you are no longer able to care for him/her, we will not refund the purchase price or provide a replacement puppy. We will not reimburse you for any purchases related to the puppy including, but not limited to, crate, toys, food, dishes, leash, collars, medicines, and/or invisible fencing or supplies related to training or travel expenses. We are also not responsible for any medical bills related to an allergic reaction to the puppy.

No Financial Responsibility: Except for the above described warranty, the BREEDER assumes no financial responsibility once this puppy/dog has left our custody. **Under NO CIRCUMSTANCES is this dog to be used for breeding unless otherwise arranged with the BREEDER.** **All Guarantees pertain to the original purchaser only.*
